Ha!

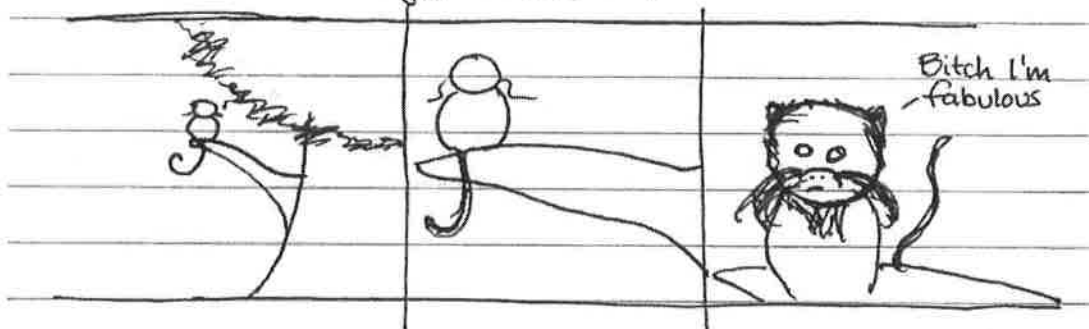
We were better than them
